## News from the East Coast (New York, Boston and Washington

On November 6<sup>th</sup>, Chairman Mr. Steven Shen and General Manager Ms. Gin Zhang had a meeting with Jonathan He who flew from New York in Las Vegas. Mr. He revealed that the promotion of the 2013 China-US Business Summit in New York has started, and has received several sponsorship requests.
